1. **Sign-up for NotifyNOW Today!**

NotifyNOW is a targeted emergency mass notification system that allows us to directly contact residents during an emergency with a phone call to a landline or cellphone, text message or email. Starting in June we will also be using this system to notify residents of service disruptions that could impact their quality of life, such as water main breaks or power outages.

If you already have a telephone listed in the phone book, than we have that number listed in our system already. However, if you would like to customize how we contact you, or if you would like to register your cell phone, simply visit Saskatoon.ca and follow the NotifyNOW logo to sign-up.

2. **Saskatchewan Lotteries Community Grant** – This grant is for Sport, Culture and Recreation projects that will be conducted between April 1st, 2015 and March 31st, 2016. Projects should provide access to sport, culture and recreation activities for all people regardless of age, sex, ethnicity, economic status, physical or mental ability. Projects to involve a specific demographic in a new cultural, recreational or sport activity are encouraged and have had great success in the past. Special ‘Days in the Park’ have been popular. Deadline to apply: **January 15th** Grants range from \$500 to a maximum of \$10,000.
