

## WUHCA Soccer Registration FAQs

### Indoor Season 2016-2017

#### Soccer information

#### 1. What are the age groups and prices?

Kidsport applications are available in cases of financial need.

#### 2. Can I register for U10 Developmental league through WUHCA?

Registration for U10 Developmental league is through the Aurora zone. Please see [www.aurorasoccer.ca](http://www.aurorasoccer.ca) for more details.

#### 3. Where and when are games held?

U6-U10 Games are scheduled by Saskatoon Youth Soccer Inc (SYSI). Please note that WUHCA does not have control over the schedules.

#### 4. When and where are U6-U10 practices held?

For U6, U8, and U10, teams will practice in schools. We hope to have practices in Willowgrove schools, space permitting. Practices will be scheduled Monday-Friday 6-9 p.m. Practice frequency, times and dates will depend on available gym time, the number

of teams that sign up, and coach preferences. You will find out your practice times from your coach.

**5. Do I have to pay to get in to the soccer centres?**

Yes- here is some information from SYSI:

Indoor Soccer Centre Season Admission Passes: (2-for-1 sale) Sept 15 - Oct 15, 2016 Those over the age of 18 will require an admission pass in order to watch soccer games at the soccer centres. There will be a 2-for-1 season admission pass sale in effect from Sept 15 to Oct 15. The season passes are \$20 each or \$3 per day, however during the sale when one pass is purchased at \$20 a second one will be provided for free. The passes are good from October 1, 2016 to Sept 31, 2017 and are not valid at tournaments.

***Registration Information***

**1. Do I need to buy a new membership?**

Yes. Memberships run September to August, so **you will need a new membership** (one per family). You must “add on” a membership as part of the online registration purchase. Your child cannot play without a valid membership, and late purchased memberships will be assessed a 50% administrative charge. We will be checking to make sure everyone purchases a membership.

**2. Can I register for WUHCA soccer online?**

There is no in-person registration.

**3. What is the registration deadline?**

**September 2nd, 2016.**

**4. Can my child play up or down an age group?**

SYSI does not allow players to “play down” an age group. Playing up an age group is usually possible, as long as there is room on the team- contact your soccer coordinator (see email addresses below) before registering.

**5. Are spots limited?**

Spots are not limited as long as we get enough volunteer coaches.

**6. How do I get a membership card?**

You will receive an email from the membership coordinator with details about how to get your card. For now, hold on to your registration receipt as proof that you purchased a membership.

**7. How can I pay for soccer?**

Paying via PayPal online is strongly encouraged. You may mail a cheque payable to WUHCA along with your child’s name and age group to:

Cheques must be mailed and postmarked by September 2nd. Late payment is subject to a \$20 late fee or may result in losing your child's place on the team.

**8. Can I coach?**

Yes! We are always in need of coaches. In fact, if a parent on your child's team does not step up to coach, we will have to refund your money and your child will not be able to play. For U6-U10, head coaches will need to take Respect in Sport (online) and may need to take a coaching clinic offered by SYSI. You do not need previous soccer experience to coach.

**9. Can I make friend requests when registering?**

Yes, you can request a friend for your child to play with. Head coaches can request more than one friend. Please realize that there are a lot of factors that go into forming teams, so these requests are not guaranteed.

**10. Can I get a refund?**

Unfortunately, no.

**11. Can I register late?**

If there is room on a team after September 2nd, you may be able to register late by contacting the relevant coordinator (see email addresses below). Late registrations are subject to a \$20 late fee.

**12. When will I get team information?**

Your coach should email you by early to mid-October. If you don't receive an email by October 10<sup>th</sup>, email your soccer coordinator.
